Mawlānā Amīnullah Anṣarī Azīmabādī and His Qaṣīdah i Uzmā

ABSTRACT

Mawlānā Amīnullah Ansari Azīmabādī was a prolific scholar, teacher, logician, writer and poet of Indian Subcontinent. He was a pupil of Imām Waliullah Muhaddith Delhvi. His scholarship can be judged from the fact that he was appointed as headmaster in Madarasah 'Āliyah Calcutta. He wrote several books on various topics which were of great benefit for the seekers of knowledge. We find in his remarkable books, a poetic treatise, Qasīdah-i Uzmā, regarding the Prophetic Strah which gained enviable reputation in his times. It is difficult to determine its first publication, however, according to 'Azīzuddīn Balkhī, it was published few times with a deluxe edition from Ansārī Press Delhi in 1303 H. The booklet comprises of 96 pages and the poet has tried to encircle the most important sides of the Prophetic life. It is a masterpiece of literature as well as a magnificent specimen from the perspective of research and authenticity. There was abundance of Mawlūd Namas in the author's time, containing the fabricated tales and traditions. He has penned a valuable work and this article focuses on its brief overview.
