In the beginning of the current term(A p r i 1 2015-March2019) Markaz Jamaat-e-Islami Hind decided to hold Tarbiyatgahs (training camps) in which selected members from the various states would be called for their academic, ideological and spiritual tarbiyah for a week. The sixth Tarbiyatgah was held from 3 to 9 September 2018. The speeches Maulana Syed Jalaluddin Omari addressed in the Introductory and Concluding sessions of the camp are being presented here in the form of an article.

The Maulana said that it is easy to make efforts for the reform and training of others but it is indeed difficult to do our own reform while the Qur'an and hadith have laid much emphasis thereon. There is very limited concept of Tazkiyah in certain circles. They concentrate only on obligatory and optional prayers and on some daily round of practice or recital incantation while Tazkiyah means a complete change of life and one's total surrender to the commandments of Allah and His Messenger (peace and blessings of Allah be to him).

Evolution of individuals is the foundation stone of Tazkiyah. Unless the evolution of individuals is effected, social change is impossible. This is why the Qur'an basically addresses individuals and promises power to an organisation consisting of morally good persons.

Our ideological evolution is also essential. We should make a deep study of other views and ideologies and analyse them in the light of Islam.

A critical appraisal of Stephen Hawking's ideas

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The British physicist Stephen Hawking (1942-2018) was well known throughout the world. He was associated with Cambridge university. Inspite of severe physical disability, he performed outstanding scientific work. He is certainly an example of sustained effort and strong will power. In that part some other aspects of the subject, Islam and Protection of Environment were highlighted. This part says that the Qur'an and Hadith command us to protect the earth and prohibit us from spreading dirt and filth therein. To remove filth and everything that can hurt people has been enjoined. A Study of Certain Ahadith Related to Woman

Considering a passage out of context may lead to wrong interpretation. Then it analyses each hadith in this regard to highlight that there is no negative approach about women if it is studied in proper context, rather it will illustrate the correct position.

Islamic Viewpoint on Advertisement of Businesses

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Doing business to earn livelihood has been enjoined. Man wants his business to flourish and his product(s) to be sold more and more. For this he takes the help of advertisement.

Generally such ways and means are adopted for advertisement as may introduce the products at mass level in a very short time. For this, newspapers, magazines, print and electronic media are used. To adopt different ways and means for advertisement of products and services is permissible from Shari'ah point of view; but the conditions therefor are that the products must be *halal* (permissible) and the time for business transaction as well as the merits and demerits of the products ought to be declared. While advertising Shari'ah rulings related to pictures must be followed in letter and spirit. Lies, fraud, deception and exaggeration ought to be avoided. Following all these conditions, every kind of advertisement can be adopted.

Hazrat Shaqiq Balkhi and his teachings

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Hazrat Shaqiq Balkhi (194H/810AD) was among the

great Sufis of the early Islamic period. He was, at the beginning, a fairly rich and successful tradesman. During his one trade journey he was influenced by some specific incident and his life was changed and he gave up all the worldly affairs and took the path of Zahid (renunciation). He became disciple of Ibraheem Adham and had also been in touch with some other Sufis of the time. The writers on Tasawwuf, compiled his words. Most of his sayings were about Tawakkul Zuhd (renunciation), concern of the life (Contentment). hereafter, negligence of the world, and so on and so forth. His Tawakkul (Contentment) was not ideological only but it was a practical one and was based on a balanced pattern. He has very minutely elaborated the characteristics of *Tasawwuf* and played a vital role in formulating the peculiar ideologies of Tasawwuf which was propagated by his disciples like Hatim Asamm.

This paper has precisely recorded the brief sketch of the life of Shaqiq Balkhi, his spiritual masters, his contemporaries and his disciples. Similarly, it mentions some of his sayings and the *Tasawwuf* ideologies he opted for.
