- It is disliked to transfer zakat funds to another country, unless there is a legitimate need

Etiquettes of Paying Zakat

- 1. Understand the rationale
 - test of love for Allah
 - ridding oneself of miserliness
 - thankfulness to Allah
- 2. Pay it in secret, preferably.
- 3. Do not ruin it by reminder and injury.
- 4. Do not consider it to be big.
- 5. Spend the best of your wealth.
- 6. Seek out the most pious, knowledgeable and dignified people. (Continued.....)
