You will feel changes in the editorship of the different sections. This is because we are providing opportunities of research to all faculty members. Therefore English and Urdu sections have their new editors, while the Arabic section has no changes. In Arabic we have only two Faculty members who have command in Arabic because they have higher degrees from Arab countries. This change has been fruitful.

As we have saved three months, we the associates of this journal have mutually decided to make the best use of time and publish two more special issues, one in June 2001 and the other in August 2001, on "SEERAT-E-TAYYABA" and "PAKISTAN" respectively. This work is in hand.

In this journal as in our previous issues, different research papers have been included which we received from University of Karachi, other universities of Pakistan and abroad. We are holding one seminar a month on the average, which is better performance than those of other faculties.
