Business Ethics in Islam

Business ethics in Islam is a very enormous and immense term. The ethics exist greater in quantity and powerful. A lot can be demonstrated on this term. Islam provides us the full fledged ethics of business if once implemented transparently; it can bring the resolution in the field of business & economy. Ethics are considered the moral standards by which people judge behaviour. Ethics are often summed up in what is considered the "golden rules" (1).

Business is an economic system in which goods & services are exchanged for one another or money, on the basis of their perceived worth. A business (also known as enterprise or firm) is an organization designed to provide goods services or both to consumers (2).

In business there are many different people you have to answer to: customers, share holders and clients. Business ethics are ethics that refer to the moral rules and regulations governing the business world. In other words they are the moral values that guide the way corporations or other business make decisions. Some business ethics are imposed by law.e.g. The Securities and Exchange Commission governs the way investment bankers and stock brokers do business, and court rules dealing with attorney client privilege dictate some ethical decisions for attorneys. However there are also business decisions that do not fall near the guide lines of the law, in which ethical or moral judgments must b made⁽³⁾.

According to Brainy Quote, Business is any particular occupation or employment engaged in for livelihood or gain, as agriculture, trade, art, or a profession. In general, business ethics is the branch of ethics that examines ethical rules & principals within a commercial contest. The various moral or ethical problems that can arise in a business setting; and any special duties or obligation that applies to persons who are engaged in commerce. Those who are interested in business ethics examine various kinds of business activities and ask, Is, the conduct ethically right or wrong? (4)

Significance and importance of business ethics can be enhanced by comparing it with the foundation of a building. It plays the same vital role just like the foundation & pillars play in constructing & designing a building

consecutively, beginning with the title page. Type the page number in the upper right-hand comer of each page in English, and in the upper left-hand comer of each page in Urdu and Arabic.

B. Abstracts:

Provide on a separate page an abstract of not more than 150 words. This abstract should consist of labeled background, Methods, Results and Conclusion. They should briefly describe, respectively, the problem being addressed in the study, how the study was performed, the salient result and what the authors conclude from the results.

C. Introduction:

State the purpose of the article and summarize the rationale for the study.

D. Key Words:

Include the Key Words relating to the article subject.

E. Results:

Present your results in logical sequence in the text.

F. Discussion:

Emphasize the new and important aspect of the study and conclusions that follow from them.

Link the conclusions with the goals of the study but avoid unqualified statements and conclusions not completely supported by your discussion and references.

G. References:

Text and references must follow the format outlined in *The Chicago Manual of Style* like (al-Ālūsī, Sayyid Muhmud al-Baghdadi. *Rūh al-Ma'ānī*, Cairo: Muniriyah Press, 1353 AH.). All footnotes citing books must contain the complete title, name of the author(s), place of publication, publishing company, and date. All foreign words must be underlined and transliterated. SZIC reserves the right to change the transliteration of all historical names, titles, and non-English terminology to bring conformity with its own style.

Editorial Policy

SZIC feels honour in providing a podium by publishing original material of interest to the research scholars, *Ulema*, and sociopolitical scientists, in the broad field of Islamic social sciences. $Al-Adw\bar{a}$ is an academic refereed journal published two times a year (Summer and Winter). Unsolicited manuscripts will be welcomed here.

Manuscript Submission

Submit two copies of the manuscript along with a soft copy (Floppy/CD) to the Editor. Manuscripts should not be submitted via Fax; e-mail may be used to transmit papers. To facilitate academic review and production, authors must provide their complete name, address, phone number(s), current position/title, and name(s) of universities on the title page.

Manuscripts will be considered for publication only if they have not been published previously and are not under consideration for publication elsewhere.

The Review Procedure

Manuscripts that are submitted to $Al-Adw\bar{a}$ are subject to evaluation by at least two independent referees (including one from technologically advanced countries) who are expert in the applicable field. The decision to accept or reject a manuscript rests solely with $Al-Adw\bar{a}$ Editorial Board. This decision is final. The Editorial Board will, however, base its decision primarily upon the recommendations of the referees who have evaluated the paper.

Format Requirements

A. General Requirements:

Unsolicited Manuscripts must be written in English/Urdu/Arabic. Type the manuscript on white bond paper, 8-1/2×11 inches (21.6×27 cm or A4 size paper) with margins of at least 1.5 inches (4cm). Type on one side of the paper only double spacing every page. Begin each of the following section on separate page and in the following order: Title page, Abstract, Introduction, Results, Discussion, and References. Number pages
