1. Dr. Abdus Sattar Siddiqui: "Urdu Tahqiq: Chand Tasrihat, Chand Tajaweez", extracts from his presidential address in the Urdu Section of 11th Session of the All India Oriental Conference, held in December 1941 at Hyderabad Deccan (pp.3-12).
2. Dr. Ghulam Mustafa Khan: "Khwaja Muhammad Hashim Kishmi". The article furnishes useful authentic information on the life and works of a renowned biographer of Shaikh Ahmad of Sirhind, and a Persian poet of calibre who lived in the 1st half of 11th century A.H. (pp. 15-41).
3. Dr. S. Ataur Raheem: "Tahqiqi Maqalat Ki Technique," observations on the technique of Urdu research writings, mainly dissertations, with some suggestions for improvement (pp.90-96).
4. Professor Abdul Haq: "Mawadi Tajziye Ka Tariqa", introduces the research technique of 'Content Analysis' to Urdu research circles, emphasizing that it can successfully be applied to Urdu literature for scientifically tracing out the trends (pp.293-302).
5. Dr. Najmul Islam: "Bayaz-i-Muqim", probes into a rare Persian bayaz of 11th century A.H. present in the Abdul Aziz Memon Collection of Allama I.I. Kazi Central Library, University of Sind, Jamshoro. (pp: 97-172).
6. Mrs. Rabia Iqbal: "Urdu Tehqiq ki Taraqqi mein Pakistani Khawateen ka Hissa," a critical study of the published dissertation written by Pakistani lady scholars for the degree of Ph.D. in Urdu,

- with a view to evaluate the work done by Pakistani women in the field of Urdu research (pp.173-216).
7. Dr. Sadia Nasim: "Zarfi 'Mein' Ka Mutala'a", an exhaustive study of the linguistic origin, growth and development of Urdu post-position 'میں' with special reference to its various forms in use in the early Urdu literature (pp.42-73).
 8. Mrs. Fahmida Shaikh: "Urdu Tahqiq Ki Ja'izani-gari," a study of the various survey reports on the advancement of Urdu research in Pakistan. (pp.-364-368).
 9. Dr. Zafar Iqbal: "Mus-hafi Ka Aik Sahib-i-Diwan Shagird", furnishes useful information on the life and hitherto rarely-known Urdu Diwans of Khwaja Abdur Ra'uf Shu'oor of Lucknow, a disciple of the renowned Urdu poet Mus-hafi (pp.73-89).
 10. Mr. Atiq Ahmad Jilani: "Mu'arif our Ghalibiyat", a study of the 70-year long services rendered by the well-known Urdu research journal "Mu'arif, Azamgarh" in the field of 'studies on Ghalib' (pp.217-243).
 11. Mirza Saleem Baig: "Saksena ki Tarikh-e-Adab-e-Urdu", critically examines the various studies made by the scholars on Askari's Urdu version of Ram Babu Saksena's "History of Urdu literature" (pp.244-292).
 12. Sayyid Javed Iqbal: "Mutala'at-e-Ameer", a critical survey of the studies made so far on the life and works of the renowned poet-scholar Ameer Meena'i of Lucknow (pp.303-370).
